

Personal Equipment List for Camp

Checklists are an excellent shorthand method for reminding people (even yourself) about important matters. In camp, one of those important matters is 'the right stuff' — clothes to suit the weather and the activities, gear to keep you clean and comfortable and so on. You should adapt this personal equipment list depending on such factors as the age of the group, the season, the location and the duration of the camp.

You should bring along to the camp the items that are ticked below.

Remember — you'll be responsible for your belongings. All items must be clearly marked with your name.

- Gumboots

- Towel
- Brush & comb
- Hair shampoo
- Thongs e.g. for showering
- Insect repellent
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Handkerchiefs
- Soap
- Sunscreen
- Personal medications

- Stamped addressed envelope
- Camera
